- Examine conditioning of psyche which influences our behaviour
- Explore your fundamental needs. Build courage, clarity, confidance, inner-connectedness and reclaim your power to make choices which are truly yours

They honor the complexity of inner world, identity formation while providing structured pathways for exploring the rich landscape of the psyche. 


Once we learn to question our beliefs and challenge them, it enables us with fresh perspectives leading to new vitality and energies in our life.

Through immersive, research-based experiences, you'll step into living situations that mirror real-life dilemmas, experiment with new ways of being, and uncover how your choices are shaped — and how they, in turn, shape you.

This is not a workshop of techniques. It is a space of experiential discovery — to listen deeply, confront patterns, and emerge with renewed clarity and courage to act from your center.

Explore Four Fundamental Human Needs

- 1. Freedom to act with awareness, not compulsion.
- 2. Power to influence your life and context impactfully.
- 3. Relations to connect authentically, beyond roles.
- 4. Joy to live with aliveness and purpose.

Five Core Objectives

- 1. Enhance Clarity See your patterns of choice-making and their impact.
- 2. Build Courage Confront inner fears that cloud authentic decisions.
- 3. Deepen Connectedness Engage in open, honest, and empathic interaction.
- 4. Strengthen Confidence Trust your inner voice amid ambiguity.
- 5. Find Centeredness Anchor yourself in values and awareness amidst chaos.

Benefits to Participants

- Reclaim your sense of agency choose with freedom, not fear.
- Gain self-awareness of how you think, feel, and act under pressure.
- Transform your relational presence listen and connect with authenticity.
- Experience renewal of energy, purpose, and self-trust.
- Translate inner clarity into outer action in life, work, and leadership.

Travel Information

• Travel has to be arranged by participants themselves.

- Hotel Wyndham Garden is approximately 70 km (about 1.5 hours) from Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi.
- The location is easily accessible by intercity / outstation cab services such as Ola and Uber and local auto-rickshaws.
- Approximate Distance from Railway Stations: New Delhi Railway Station 55 km (1 1.5 hours); Gurugram Railway Station: 75 km (~1.5- 2 hours); Sonipat Railway Station: 10 km (~15 minutes).
- There are frequent bus services from ISBT Kashmere Gate Terminal to Sonipat (1 to 2.5 hours), and get down at Murthal. You can easily book it from ISBT Kashmere Gate bus counters or using any of the online travel booking apps / websites.
- The Delhi Metro's last station to get to Sonipat will be part of the Yellow Line extension, currently under construction, with the last station being Nathupur. Wyndham Garden is about 20km away from Nathupur, Haryana.
- Please book the flight/train accordingly AFTER the closing time of the event, as per the programme schedule. Participants leaving before the closure of the lab/event will be deemed to have NOT completed the course. Therefore, they shall not be issued a certificate of participation and may not be eligible for further journeys without completing the said lab.
- **Important Note**: Since the event is happening in winter there might be a situation of fog, please keep sufficient time margins while booking your tickets so as to reach the venue before programme start time and to catch your transportation post the event completion time.
